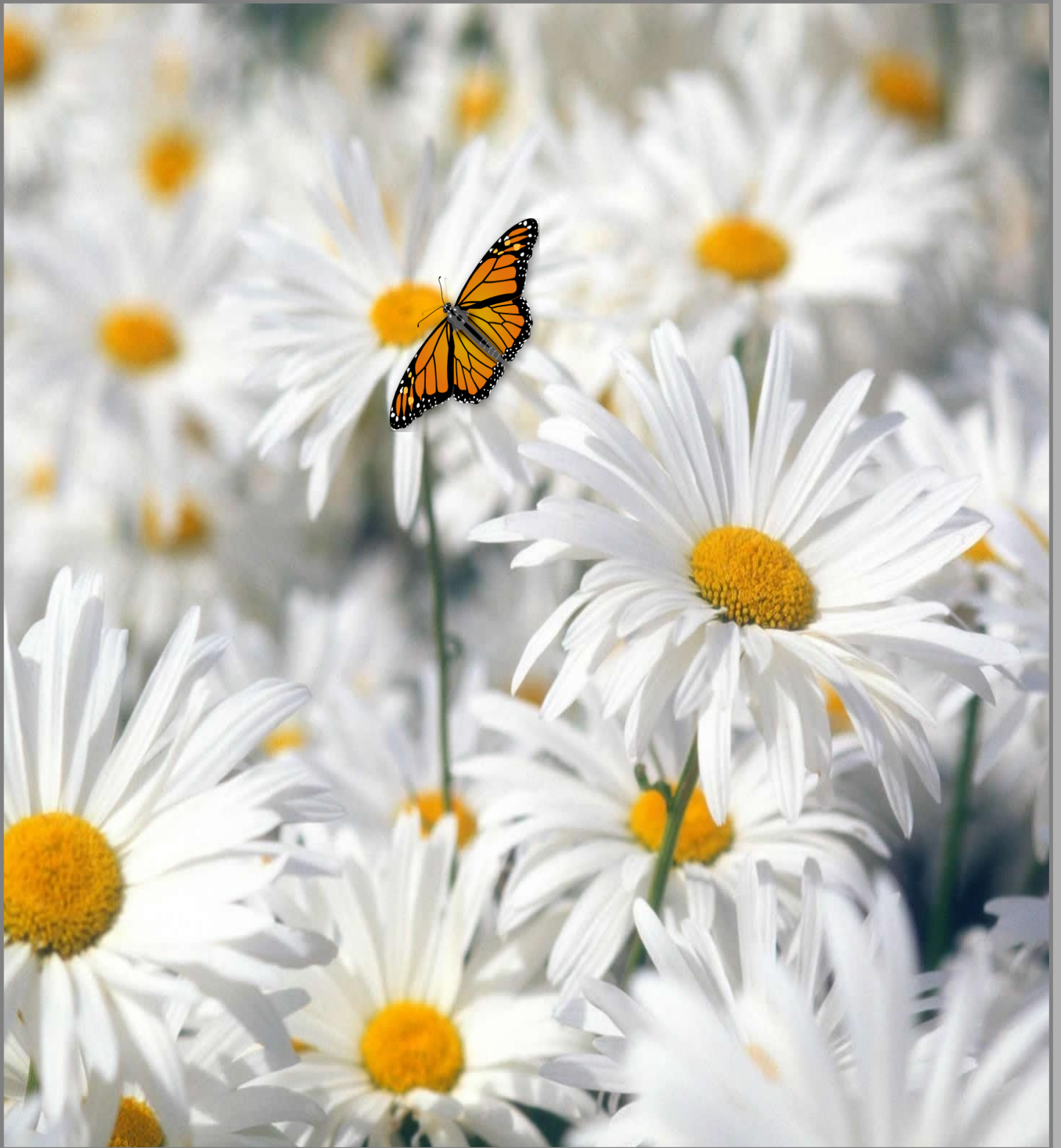

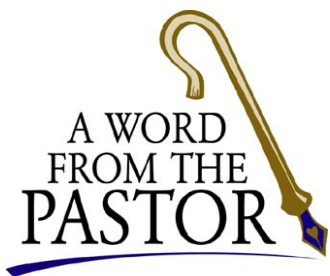

Great Encouragement

Not many years ago a song was recorded and distributed across the world. It became very popular with Christian and people in general. Many of us adopted the lyrics of the song as our own and tried to follow its direction. Many people began singing the song, smiling, shouting, rejoicing, and praising the Lord because of this song. The key words to that song was "Sometimes you have to encourage yourself."

I agreed with that song to a certain degree, then I remembered that many people tried but failed at encouraging themselves. I begin to ponder the word encourage, I thought about the word encouragement and how many occasions encouragement was hard to find even from oneself. Encourage according to Webster, means to give support, confidence or hope to oneself or someone else.

So, the question today is where do you go, where do you turn, when you can't encourage yourself? When your troubles seem to be more than you can stand. Who do you call when no one is available to take your call? Where do you turn when there is no one to turn to?

Don't get upset, don't get depressed, just turn to Isaiah chapter 41 and read verses 10-13. These four verses confirm that all of us can turn to the Lord for encouragement. He's never too busy for any of His children. So, when you're feeling a little low and in need of encouragement, try reading these words:

¹⁰ Fear thou not; for I *am* with thee: Be not dismayed; for I *am* thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; Yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness. ¹¹ Behold, all they that were incensed against thee shall be ashamed and confounded: They shall be as nothing; and they that strive with thee shall perish. ¹² Thou shalt seek them, and shalt not find them, *even* them that contended with thee: They that war against thee shall be as nothing, and as a thing of nought. ¹³ For I the LORD thy God will hold thy right hand, Saying unto thee, Fear not; I will help thee. (Isaiah 41:10-13)

"Sometimes you have to encourage yourself" turned out to be a hit song and made a great many people happy. However, if you really want true happiness and encouragement, open your bible, read the scriptures and talk to the Lord. He will encourage your heart.

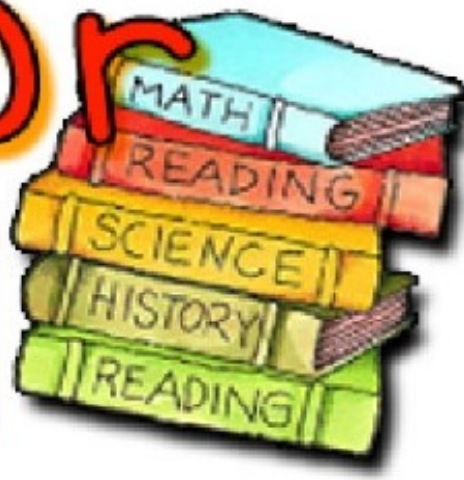
